

# RED CROSS OFFERING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

**The American Red Cross is continuing intake requests for Individual Financial Assistance (IFA) through 1 June 2026 for households that were impacted by Typhoon Sinlaku.**

## Financial Assistance Eligibility

Assistance is available only to individuals whose primary residences (structure) were **destroyed** or suffered **major damage**.

Please include:

- Address in the **subject** line
- Name of Residents
- Photos of the damage to your primary residence

Affected individuals can also send a message via WhatsApp to **571-242-1829** with:

- Name
- Address
- Photos of Structure Damage

Once your information is received, **the Red Cross will contact you** to schedule an appointment at our office (Building 285, Route 4, Hagåtña, Guam 96910, next to the Superior Court of Guam). Appointments will be scheduled between 8:00AM and 4:00PM Monday through Friday. **We kindly request you do not show up to the office without a scheduled appointment.**

At your appointment, please ensure you bring the requested documents for proof of Identity and Address Verification.

### Proof of identity

- Passports
- Permanent Resident Cards
- Government/Military IDs

### Address Verification

- Mayor's Verification Letter (*highly preferred*)
- Recent Utility Bill
- Rental Agreements
- Mortgage Statements

Additional documentation requirements may be discussed when your appointment is scheduled.
