FEMA Continues to Offer Free Rebuilding and Repair Tips at Local Stores

Do you have questions about rebuilding and repairing following Typhoon Mawar? FEMA Mitigation specialists may give you advice or offer free tips on how to rebuild stronger and safer against storms. This is an ongoing commitment to support Guam residents on their recovery journey. FEMA Disaster Survivor Assistance staff will also be onsite to help with registration status checks or application appeals.

On the following dates, four teams of FEMA experts in Mitigation and Disaster Survivor Assistance will be available at the following locations, including two new sites:

Each location will have an Assistive Listening Device for customers who may have hearing difficulty.

The Disaster Recovery Center (DRC) at Guam Community College remains open until Aug. 16 during its regular hours 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday-Friday, 9 a.m. to 6 p.m., Saturday, and closed on Sunday. DRCs are barrier-free and provide equal access to all visitors. If you use American Sign Language or assistive technology, and if you need accommodations to communicate, notify FEMA staff at the center immediately.
