DPHSS tested 250 individuals for COVID-19 on Thursday, July 9, 2020 with conclusive results. One tested positive and 249 tested negative for SARS-CoV-2. Results include 191 samples from COVID-19 community testing held at the Astumbo Gym on July 8. The positive case was identified through community screening.

To date, there have been a total of **310** confirmed cases of COVID-19 with **5** deaths, **202** released from isolation, and **103** active cases. Of those cases, **264 are classified as civilians** and **46 are military service members**.
