Cumulative Results: Forty-seven Test Positive for COVID-19; Profiles of Confirmed Cases

Of the 47 newly reported cases, 20 cases were identified through contact tracing and one case reported recent travel from the United States and was identified in quarantine. Eighty-five (85) cases were reported released from isolation.

To date, there have been a total of **1,494** confirmed cases of COVID-19 with **13** deaths, **653** not in isolation, and **828** cases in active isolation. Of those cases, **1,271** are classified as civilians and **223** are military service members.
