**Cumulative Results: 43 Test Positive for COVID-19; Profiles of Confirmed Cases**

COVID-19 test results are reported from multiple labs at varying times of the day. The Joint Information Center will report cumulative COVID-19 test results once a day, unless unavailable.

Of the 43 newly reported cases, 31 cases were identified through contact tracing. Five were identified in quarantine: three cases reported recent travel from the U.S. and two cases reported recent travel from the Philippines.

To date, there have been a total of **2,190** officially reported cases of COVID-19 with **37** deaths, **646** cases in active isolation, and **1,507** not in active isolation. Of those cases, **1,924** are classified as civilians and **266** are military service members.
