## 49th COVID-19-Related Fatality Reported; Cumulative Results: 45 Test Positive for COVID-19; Profiles of Confirmed Cases

COVID-19 test results are reported from multiple labs at varying times of the day. The Joint Information Center will report cumulative COVID-19 test results once a day, unless unavailable.

## 49th COVID-19-Related Fatality Reported

The Joint Information Center was notified that Guam's 49th COVID-19-related fatality occurred at the Guam Memorial Hospital (GMH) at approximately 4:16 p.m. The patient was a 70-year-old male with underlying health conditions that were compounded by COVID-19. He was admitted to GMH on August 30 and was a known COVID case.

"With each passing, we are reminded just how fragile life can be. We should never take each day for granted. Let's take this time to reach out to family and loved ones to check up on them and see how they are doing. COVID-19 can be isolating, but we must remember that we are not alone," said Governor Lou Leon Guerrero. "To his family and friends, Jeff, Lt. Governor Josh, and I offer our deepest condolences. In this difficult time, I hope you find comfort from the outpouring of support from the community."

## **Cumulative Results**

To date, there have been a total of **2,488** officially reported cases of COVID-19 with **49** deaths, **617** cases in active isolation, and **1,822** not in active isolation. Of those cases, **2,215** are classified as civilians and **273** are military service members.

Forty-five (45) cases of COVID-19 were reported today to the Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS). Forty-three (43) of those are confirmed cases, and two are probable cases. Of the 45 cases, 24 cases were identified through contact tracing.
