91st COVID-19-Related Fatality Reported

The Joint Information Center was notified that Guam's 91st COVID-19-related fatality occurred at the Guam Memorial Hospital (GMH) at approximately 11:39 a.m. The patient was a 37-year-old male. He was admitted to GMH on November 3, 2020 and was a known positive case.

"On behalf of the people of Guam, we send our deepest condolences and sympathies to his family and friends. May the love and support from those near you bring you some comfort in this most difficult of time," said Governor Lou Leon Guerrero. "In moments of grief, we are told that with time, our hearts will be healed and our wounds will be bound. However, as we learned from this pandemic, time is a luxury we do not have.
