**COR 1 Remains in Effect; Tentative Plans to Return to COR 4 by Noon Today;
 GIAA Flight Changes; Shelter Updates**

COR 1 Remains in Effect; Tentative Plans to Return to COR 4 by Noon Today

At this time, Condition of Readiness (COR) 1 remains in effect. Based on Tropical Storm Man-Yi’s current track, Acting Governor Josh Tenorio anticipates returning to Condition of Readiness (COR) 4 by noon today, with GovGuam to return to work by 1 p.m. The only deviation from this plan would be a drastic change in Man-Yi’s trajectory. A final announcement will be made by 11 a.m.

A **tropical storm warning** remains in effect for Guam and Rota, meaning tropical storm conditions, including damaging winds of 39 mph or more, are imminent or occurring. A **Coastal Flood Advisory** and **Rip Current Statement** remains in effect.

As of 8 a.m. ChST, Tropical Storm Man-Yi is 50 miles SouthWest of Guam, moving Southwest at 18 mph with sustained winds at 50mph and expected to intensify through Thursday, possibly becoming a Typhoon North of Yap.
