### **GHS/OCD Hosts Critical Infrastructure Training Opportunities**

The Offices of Guam Homeland Security and Civil Defense (GHS/OCD), in conjunction with the Texas A&M Engineering Extension Service (TEEX), will host the following training opportunities at the GHS/OCD facility in Agana Heights:

- Tuesday, June 11, 2024, 8 a.m. – 12 p.m.: Critical Infrastructure Security and Resilience Awareness (AWR-213)
  - The half-day training is offered at no cost to eligible participants and will introduce participants to the key term, policy, guidance, and preparedness efforts required to safeguard the nation's critical infrastructure.
  - The target audience for the course include personnel involved with critical infrastructure and emergency management partners from the government of Guam, military, federal, private, and non-profit organizations.
