The Offices of Guam Homeland Security and Civil Defense (GHS/OCD), in conjunction with the Texas A&M Engineering Extension Service (TEEX), will host the following training opportunities at the GHS/OCD facility in Agana Heights:

- Monday, March 25, 2024, 8 a.m. – 12 p.m.: Essentials of Community Cybersecurity (AWR-136)
 - The half-day training is offered at no cost to eligible participants and provides participants with an introduction to concepts related to community cybersecurity.
