GHS/OCD Hosts Training Opportunities for Healthcare Organizations and Electric Power Systems

The Offices of Guam Homeland Security and Civil Defense (GHS/OCD), in conjunction with the Texas A&M Engineering Extension Service (TEEX), will host the following training opportunities at the GHS/OCD facility in Agana Heights:

- Tuesday, July 23 – Wednesday, July 24, 2024, 8 a.m. – 5 p.m.: **Disaster Preparedness for Healthcare Organizations within the Community Infrastructure** (MGT-341)
 - The two-day training is offered at no cost to eligible participants and provides an opportunity for participants to acquire the knowledge and skills necessary to help them ensure the sustainability of their resources, facilities, and organizations during all types of disasters.
 - The target audience for the course include individuals from the healthcare community who are responsible for ensuring the resiliency of healthcare services during high consequence or catastrophic events, and emergency management partners from the government of Guam, military, federal, private, and non-profit organizations.
