To commemorate the month, Governor Lou Leon Guerrero will declare NPM with a virtual proclamation signing on Friday, September 1, 2023 at 11:30 a.m., which will also be streamed live on the Governor's Facebook page.

## The 2023 NPM theme is "Preparing for Older Adults."

NPM is an observance each September to raise awareness about the importance of preparing for disasters and emergencies that could happen at any time.

"We recognize the importance of preparedness for the whole community and appreciate the focus for this year's theme as older adults can face greater risks when it comes to the multitude of extreme weather events and emergencies we now face, especially if they are living alone, have a disability, or live in hard to reach areas," said Charles Esteves, Civil Defense Administrator. "What is great about our community is that in times of emergency, our island pulls together – neighbors support each other, communities react with compassion, and afterward, we emerge stronger and more resilient."
