To commemorate the month, Governor Lou Leon Guerrero will declare NPM with a proclamation signing on Friday, September 6, 2024 at 9:30 a.m. at the Ricardo J. Bordallo Governor's Complex, Large Conference Room.

The 2024 NPM theme is, "Empowering Asian American, Native Hawaiian, and Pacific Islander communities to Prepare for Risks and Disasters."

NPM is an observance each September to raise awareness about the importance of preparing for disasters and emergencies that could happen at any time.

"This year's NPM theme highlight's FEMA's commitment to ensuring our diverse communities have the tools we need to be prepared for future risk," said Charles Esteves, Civil Defense Administrator.
