GHS/OCD to Conduct Retest of All Hazards Alert Warning System Sirens, April 7, at 3:45 PM

The Offices of Guam Homeland Security and Civil Defense (GHS/OCD) will conduct a retest of the All Hazards Alert Warning System (AHAWS) sirens today, April 7, 2026 at 3:45 p.m.

The retest is being conducted to assess operations. Residents, visitors and motorists surrounding the AHAWS sirens can expect to hear pre-scripted voice messaging announcing the start and end of the test, and the "Alert" tone.

Future tests of the AHAWS sirens will be conducted on a monthly basis, in conjunction with NBG and AAFB, and will typically fall on the first Tuesday of each month, unless it falls on an observed holiday.
