
Construction companies and contractors on Guam can resume operations subject to meeting minimum requirements in the Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS) Contractor Clearance Checklist.

DPHSS issued a Directive suspending all construction projects on Guam effective close of business Saturday, November 14, 2020, until further notice from DPHSS. This was due to the finding of significant clusters of COVID-19 positive cases among the employees of local construction companies.

Construction companies and contractors requesting for clearance must fill out the DPHSS Contractor Clearance Checklist and Attachment A. Subcontractors to Black Construction Corporation and Core Tech International are listed in Attachment B.
